

Management Scholarships and Awards for Students

We are pleased to announce the establishment of several scholarships and awards to recognize and reward our students' outstanding achievements and contributions. These scholarships and awards have been created to support and encourage academic excellence and proficiency within the MBA department.

1. Merit Scholarship

This scholarship recognizes students with outstanding academic performance in qualifying examinations, such as the Degree, Entrance Test, Group Discussion, and Interviews. It is designed to acknowledge and support new students demonstrating exceptional potential and promise.

2. Academic Proficiency Award (Yearly)

This award is presented to three students (irrespective of the batch) who achieve the highest academic standing in the first year of the MBA program. It recognizes and celebrates the hard work, dedication, and academic excellence of MBA students. Due weightage will be given to academic paper presentations/publications.

3. Overall Academic Proficiency Award

This scholarship is awarded to students who have demonstrated outstanding overall academic proficiency and academic achievements throughout their entire course of study. Due weightage will be given to academic paper presentations/publications.

4. Best Outgoing Student Award

This prestigious award is presented to the graduating student who has excelled in all areas, including academics, paper presentations and publications, leadership roles,

community service, and extracurricular activities and made notable contributions to the department. The Best Outgoing Student exemplifies the highest standards of excellence and serves as a role model for peers and a true ambassador of our department. Due weightage will be given to the opinion of the Department Faculty Council.

5. Best Mentor Group Award

This award recognizes the significance of teamwork and peer support by honouring the mentor group that has demonstrated outstanding academic, co-curricular, and leadership performance, leaving a lasting impact. The Best Mentor Group is selected based on their collective achievements and contributions to the department and the college.

6. Scholarship for Economically Disadvantaged Students

Additionally, a select number of special scholarships are available for economically disadvantaged students, awarded based on a combination of merit and genuine financial need. A minimum of 60% marks in the Degree examination is expected to apply for the same. The availability of funds limits the number of such scholarships awarded.
