# Management Scholarships and Awards for Students

We are pleased to announce the establishment of several scholarships and awards to recognise and reward our students' outstanding achievements and contributions. These scholarships and awards have been created to support and encourage academic excellence and proficiency within the MBA department. Students will be informed of the award criteria at the beginning of the academic year.

## 1. Merit Scholarship (First-year students)

This scholarship recognises students with outstanding academic performance in qualifying examinations, such as the Degree, Entrance Test, Group Discussion, Interviews and other achievements as per the criteria below. It is designed to acknowledge and support new students demonstrating exceptional potential and promise.

## 2. Academic Proficiency Award (Annual)

This award is presented to the students who achieve the highest academic standing in the first year of the MBA program. It recognizes and celebrates the hard work, dedication, and various academic achievements of MBA students.

### 3. Overall Academic Proficiency Award

This scholarship is awarded to students who have demonstrated outstanding overall academic proficiency and other academic achievements throughout their entire course of study.

#### 4. Best Mentee Award

It is awarded to one student from each mentor group in both academic years. This recognition honors individuals who have consistently displayed outstanding performance, commitment, and personal growth. The Best Mentee is characterized by their proactive attitude, reliability, and the ability to make the most of mentoring opportunities.

#### 5. Best Outgoing Student Award

This prestigious award is conferred upon the graduating student who has demonstrated exceptional performance across multiple domains—academics, research, leadership, community engagement, and extracurricular involvement. The recipient is someone who has made significant contributions to the department, embodies the highest standards of excellence, and serves as an inspiring role model and ambassador of MIM.

#### 6. Best Mentor Group Award

This award celebrates the power of collaboration, peer support, and collective achievement. It is presented to the mentor group that has shown exemplary performance in academics, co-curricular activities, leadership initiatives, and departmental contributions. The Best Mentor Group is one that has created a positive impact on the college community.

### 7. Scholarship for Economically Disadvantaged Students (MIM CARE)

A select number of special scholarships are available for economically disadvantaged students, awarded based on a combination of merit and genuine financial need. A minimum of 60% marks in the Degree examination is mandatory to apply for the same. The number of such scholarships is limited by the availability of funds.
